A Story of Hope

Tanzila Khatun, now living in Manda, Dhaka, once survived by begging to feed her family. With her father paralyzed and three sisters living with disabilities, she had no other option. Through the Underprivileged Empowerment Program of Projects for Humanity, she received a digital weight and height measurement machine—giving her a dignified way to earn. From earning 400–500 BDT a day, she now earns 1,000–1,200 BDT daily and saves for her future.

Tanzila's journey is not just about income, it's about dignity, stability, and renewed hope.

Through engaging sessions on teamwork, communication, and character building, students gained practical skills and inspiration to lead with integrity and excellence.



Vice President's Visit to the Orphan Center

Dr. Syed Ziauddin, Vice President of Projects for Humanity, visited our Mymensingh Orphan Care Center with his father last January. Their visit was a heartfelt gesture of care and inspiration, motivating our children.



This January, Projects for Humanity secured full ownership of its first 0.61-acre land, planned for a comprehensive complex with orphan care, clinic, and training center creating a lasting hub of care and empowerment.



In order to maintain the same brand and create greater impact with shared values and principles, Projects for Humanity Bangladesh (P4HBD) has been registered and has received official approval from the Government of Bangladesh.
