In May, 226 individuals received free medical care through 4 health camps, including general checkups, gynecology, eye care, and dental services for vulnerable communities.

Through our empowerment initiative, we create sustainable income-generating opportunities for impoverished individuals. To date, we have provided 688 families with the vital tools and guidance needed to earn a living, transforming over 3,100 lives.



FOOD & NUTRITION

Sharing the Blessings of Qurbani

Under our Food and Nutrition Project, 163 Qurbani animals were sacrificed this Eid-ul-Adha, distributing meat packages to 2,345 families across 10 districts. Additionally, around 15,200 nutritious meals were provided to orphans and underprivileged children.

A Story of Hope

A mother shared her heartbreaking story with us, holding back tears:

There was a time when I was well-off. But after losing my husband, I fell into the trap of fraudulent brokers and lost absolutely everything. Now, I am completely destitute, struggling every single day to survive with my three children. We don't even have a proper roof over our heads. I sell dried fish just to put food in my children's mouths.

"You have provided this meat for my three children. As we share this meal, I will pray that Allah showers His blessings upon you all."

Her story is one of thousands. This Eid, your support helped deliver Qurbani meat to vulnerable families, refugees, orphaned children, tiger widows, coastal communities, and many others facing hardship across Bangladesh.

Grundfos CleanFlow Nearing Launch in Houston

Construction of the Grundfos CleanFlow mobile support trailer in Houston, USA, is nearing completion and remains on track for launch next month. The initiative will provide showers, laundry, meals, clothing, career guidance, and ID recovery support to help individuals experiencing homelessness move toward stability and dignity.



Two New Water Plants Ready for Launch

We are pleased to announce that two new solar-powered Reverse Osmosis (RO) water treatment plants are now fully completed. Following successful system testing and quality checks, both plants are expected to be inaugurated next month, expanding access to safe drinking water in coastal communities.



Academic & Creative Excellence

Champion Academy students achieved outstanding success in the National High School Programming Contest 2026, with four students advancing from the regional round to the national level. Additionally, two students earned top positions in the Marks All-Rounder Competition and qualified for the Divisional Round in the Music and Acting.



Orphan Care Students Shine in Upazila Competitions

Students from our Chapainawabganj Orphan Care Center achieved outstanding results in the Upazila-level Primary Education Medal Competition 2026. Md. Mahim secured 1st place in Hamd & Naat and 2nd place in Nazrul Geeti, while Md. Abu Said earned 1st place in the 100-meter sprint.

In the coming month, we will continue empowering vulnerable communities through education, orphan care, healthcare, clean water, and humanitarian support. We also look forward to inaugurating two new solar-powered RO plants and expanding our impact across Bangladesh and beyond.
