FREE MEDICAL CARE

In April, 381 individuals received free medical care through 6 health camps, including general checkups, gynecology, eye care, and dental services for vulnerable communities.



UNDERPRIVILEGED EMPOWERMENT

Through livelihood and empowerment initiatives, 688 families, impacting over 3,100 individuals received opportunities for a more stable and hopeful future.



FOOD & NUTRITION

Throughout April, over 21,500 healthy and nutritious meals were served to vulnerable individuals helping improve health, strength, and daily wellbeing.

A Story of Hope

Kausar Uddin from Gouripur had to stop his studies after SSC because of poverty. Life quickly turned into a daily struggle to support his family.

With just one sewing machine, he started a small tailoring shop—working hard every day just to keep going. Yet inside him lived a quiet hope: to build a better future not only for himself, but also for others facing the same hardship. At that critical moment, Projects for Humanity stepped in and supported him with two electric auto sewing machines. That small support became a turning point in his life.

“My parents are both sick at home. I will never forget the support you have given me in this moment of my life. It is a kindness I will carry forever.”

Today, Kausar stands on his own feet and is now creating opportunities for others. He trains two people at a time, passing on skills and hope. From struggle to strength, his journey has become a source of light for many others.
