In July, 320 individuals received free medical care through 5 health camps, including general checkups, gynecology, eye care, and dental services for vulnerable communities.

Through our sustainable livelihood initiatives, 688 families have now been empowered with income-generating opportunities, transforming the lives of more than 3,200 individuals.



FOOD & NUTRITION

More than 14000 nutritious meals were served to orphans and vulnerable individuals throughout July, helping improve health, strength, and overall wellbeing.

Standing With Families in the Flood

The flood swept away my home and everything we had. I have nothing left.
I don't know what to do with my family.

A father shared his pain as he worried about where his children would sleep and what they would eat. Even after receiving food, the worry in his eyes remained. His story reflects the reality of thousands of families whose homes and livelihoods were swept away by the devastating floods. More than 50 people, including women and children, lost their lives.

Through our Emergency Disaster Response, Projects for Humanity quickly mobilized rescue, relief, essential medicines, and post-flood support, reaching 2,000+ people with immediate assistance.
